Course Descriptions

DISCIPLE FAST TRACK: Becoming Disciples Through Bible Study - Disciple Fast Track maintains the integrity and principles of the original 34 week study, but its modifications better meet the needs of a hectic lifestyle. Participants will receive a thorough introduction to the Bible in less time using the same Disciple Study Manual. Classes meet for a total of 24 weeks, 12 sessions on the Old and New Testaments each.

DISCIPLE III: Remember Who You Are - The driving idea in this study is the connection between memory and identity as the people of God. The word “You” in the title is meant to be heard both in its singular form (the individual) and its plural form (the community). We are a community of memory. Participants in this thirty-two week study will read the major and minor Old Testament prophets, with the exception of Daniel, and will read the thirteen Letters traditionally attributed to Paul. To establish the historical context in which the prophets spoke for God, daily reading assignments draw also on the books of Deuteronomy through Chronicles.

Several themes weave their way through the study – the call to remember; the call to repentance; the need for renewed vision; and the place of community. The prophets and Paul are continually calling hearers and readers

back to their God and to a sense of who they are as a people “set apart”. Must have completed Disciple I or Disciple Fast Track.

CHRISTIAN BELIEVER – Know God with heart and mind: This study focuses on classical teachings of the Christian faith—presenting, explaining, and interpreting them in a way that participants can understand, through the use of words, symbols, and hymns. Over a 30-week period, participants will examine the writings of ancient and modern Christian commentators and view video presentations by leading Bible scholars. Must have completed Disciple I or Disciple Fast Track.

LIVING SINGLE - This 8-week session is designed to help you wrestle with the struggles, challenges, and joys of being single. You will discuss how to enjoy being single in a couples' world, reviews the benefits of being single, and considers how singles can embrace and overcome the challenges they face while waiting for marriage. It also looks at how long singles should keep hoping, where the desire for marriage comes from, and what to do with it, and how to stand strong in the face of sexual temptation.

This study helps us understand that singles can find contentment. Contentment isn't connected to finding a spouse, but rather, to tending to our soul.
